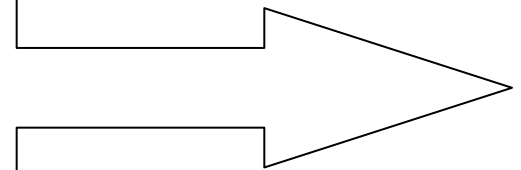
**SUE HARDING:** 1<sup>ST</sup> For the terrific attendance at this evenings meal and for our 3 guests being able to join us.
