Basically listen to all the things that our mothers preached to us while we were growing up. **BE AWARE BE PREPARED**

Damsel in Defense not only sells products like stun guns, and pepper spray. They also have roadside emergency kits called “ Junk in the trunk “ this kit is equipped with

water, snack bars, deck of cards, jumper cables, warming blanket and more.

There stun guns have wrist bands so that you can easily carry the item and sometimes just by setting it off the sound will deter a potential threatening person. If this person was able to get the stun gun from you once it is pulled away and the pin is pulled out it is disabled to the potential attacker is unable to turn and use it against you.

They also teach women some basic self defense skills.

The thumb is the weakest point of any grip.

Sing = Stomach

Instep

Noise

Groin.

If you feel you are being followed do not panic, do not keep walking turn on your heel and shout “ Why are you following me? “ First it will catch the potential attacker off guard. No need to worry about what those around you are

thinking when you do this. More than likely you will never see any of them again. And the most important factor is you may just have warded off a potential threat to your life.
