They had a family of sorts and a sign language posted to let travelers know where they would be welcomed or persecuted and run out of town. They knew where they could get work and a meal and even where there were mean dogs!! They also found out that riding the rails could be dangerous and they could lose arms and legs trying to hop a moving train!! Dave, who is an honorary member of the Hobos, gave a great talk and showed some pictures from the past. He also had a wonderful display of the life of Hobo.
