GUEST SPEAKER

This evening's Guest Speaker was Ms. Jillian Solan from the "Summit County Children Services". This organization was started back in 1881. In 1887 the county purchased land on Arlington Street in Akron and it became the agency's permanent site. It was a place for office work along with providing housing to many children who had been removed from their families. Due to new federal and state laws in 1985 Anderson Village was closed down. The objective today for social workers is to keep the children with their immediate families when at all possible. If not possible they are sent to foster homes. Each Social Worker has approximately 9 families that they are responsible for. Meaning they meet with the parents, with & without the child present, Teachers, Schools and the Child. They try circumstances warranting to keep the families together. But ultimately this depends on the circumstances as to why they were contacted. They have started up several new projects such as the Father Factor which is helped by two Akron Area local Pastors.

The main objective of this organization is to protect each child in the community. Depending on the help that is needed this can be very expensive on a daily basis. Levy # 73 which is on the ballot this fall, if passed would be a great resource for this organization. If you have any questions or would like to know more please visit the website.
