QUARTER AUCTION

This Saturday Evening from 7:00 pm until 10:00 pm is the Quarter Auction hosted by Kerri of Kerri's Confections. She has assembled 23 various vendors to participate in this wonderful fund raising event. Each vendor has donated 1 - 2 items for Auction. Bids for each item will be placed in quarters. EX: An item with a \$ 19.99 retail value the bid would be one quarter, \$ 20 - \$ 39.99 = 2 quarter bid and so on.

The doors for this event will open at 6:00 pm arrive early as each vendor will have their table set up and have their item or items going up for auction on their tables. By arriving at 6:00pm you will have the opportunity to walk around meet the individual vendors, and look at the items to be auctioned off. Auctions will start at 7:00pm All ticket sales are on a pre sale basis at a cost of \$ 5.00 each. You will get one paddle that has been assigned a number. This is what you will use to bid with. There is also the opportunity to purchase more bidding paddles at the door.

Several items will be auctioned off and then we will take a brief intermission for everyone to again view what the vendors have for auction or sale and to have a little fellowship.
