SUE HARDING reported on Division 16E Council Meeting held at Menches Restaurant in Green Tues. May 6. Tom Prentice from Kenmore explained a proposal to restructure some of the divisions in Ohio District so that every division will have 12-15 clubs and the decision will be made in August by the Board of Ohio District based upon recommendations by Governor Martin. Since 16E has only 7 clubs, the following changes have been proposed: 16W LOSES BATH-RICHFIELD TO 24 AND WEST AKRON TO 20, GAINS KENMORE FROM 16E AND BECOMES JUST 16; AKRON DOWNTOWN, ALL-CITY, NORTH AKRON AND S.E. SUMMIT GO TO 20; GREEN AND PORTAGE LAKES GO TO 17; 16E CEASES TO EXIST. This means that Tuesday, Aug. 5, 2008 will probably be our last Div. 16E Council Meeting.
