Some ideas are: water bottles, blankets, hats, gloves, scarves, socks, notebooks, pens, highlighters, band aids, decks of cards, toothbrushes and toothpaste, soap, shampoo, conditioner, hand sanitizer, flashlights, combs, chap stick, stuffed animals, small toys, word search puzzle books, deodorant, crayons, markers, handheld games, granola bars, gum/mints, play dough.
